



Camp STIX Children of Volunteers Policy

Dependent children of Camp STIX volunteers are welcome to attend camp (*Preference will be given to children with diabetes*). However, the focus of Camp STIX is to promote independence as a positive experience of the camper. In order to better serve the needs of all youth with diabetes attending Camp STIX, the following guidelines have been adopted and implemented regarding the children of Camp STIX volunteers and must be adhered to:

- A discounted price of \$450 per camper with diabetes is granted for every parent volunteer who stays for the entire session. Families will be responsible for remaining tuition to help offset the cost of food and lodging. Discounts for partial-week volunteering will not be offered. Discounts for non-diabetic campers will not be offered. (Scholarships are available for campers that have diabetes that are financially in need).
- Current Camp STIX Board of Directors' children (limit 2) may attend at no charge with priority being given to campers with diabetes before campers without diabetes.
- All registration forms, releases, and deposits must be returned by the appropriate deadlines.
- Camper will be placed in an age-appropriate cabin with other children. Volunteers will be housed with other staff away from their campers.
- Camper will remain with the cabin at all times, day or night.
- Camper agrees to follow the same routine as the other campers.
- Parent/Guardian agrees to not interfere with the camper's routine and/or the program staff's rules, regulations, cabin life, or discipline.
- The parent/guardian agrees to not enter the camper's cabin unless fulfilling the duties of their volunteer role.
- The parent/guardian will be responsible for the camper in all pre-camp activities until the time of camper registration.
- Responsibility for the camper will remain with the appropriate staff during the camp session.
- Camper agrees to not interfere with the volunteer's duties and responsibilities.
- The volunteer or any staff member will not give preferential treatment to any camper at any time during the session. Camper must be treated with the same attention as all other campers.

Special circumstances and/or arrangements may be presented to the Camp Leadership Team for review. Any deviation from this policy is at the sole discretion of the Camp Leadership Team.
